### Once Upon a Time with Peggy Bird

Using writing prompts and fun lessons on writing techniques, students write individual stories as well as collaborate on a play which they will perform on the last day of class. Taught by local writer Peggy Bird whose work has appeared in children's magazines and whose scripts have been adopted for performance by Kids on the Block Awareness Program.
